

Improve Beverly Hills Park

The existing play area is designed for ages 6 and up. Through this project, children ages 2 to 5 years old will be met with a new children's play area that includes equipment for autism sensory development.

Who Benefits

The park improvements will create a central point for community activity. A toddler/autism sensory play area is recommended by health providers and advocates of childhood development and autism support services.

Detailed Project Description

For the last 4 to 5 years the park has been equipped with a standard playground set of two slides, but only one swing for kids 5 years and older. The surrounding neighborhoods that the park was intended to service have been, for the most part, driven away in search of better equipped parks that meet the needs of their families.

Adding another swing will allow more than one person to swing at a time, thereby providing an opportunity for kids, friends and or family members, to swing together. Additionally, the creation of a dedicated Toddler/ Autism Sensory Play area will provide a safe separation from the play activities of older children. Children 2 to 5 years old in general and children with autism benefit from the use of many of the same play equipment.
