MARE ISLAND WESTERN APPROACH REPLACEMENT BRIDGE PROJECT – BRIDGE CLOSURE ON OCTOBER 16, 2015

VALLEJO, CA – Pile driving (Four Piles) and concrete placement has been completed for the first phase of the West Approach project. The bridge abutment will be filled with concrete this week and the bridge deck precast panels next week. The first phase will be completed by installing approach slab and handrails, and is anticipated to be completed by early November. At that time, traffic will then be redirected to the new deck, and the same demolition/pile driving/abutment and decking work will occur on the remaining half of the bridge.

Please note: The full daytime closure (9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) will be necessary on Friday, October 16, 2015, for placing precast panels for the deck. A crane will be placed in the travel lane for lifting and placement of the panels, each weighing approximately 42,000 pounds. Project Substantially Complete: January 2016
